Electronic Stock Market Strategies II



This class is a follow-up course to Electronic Stock Market Strategies. Further topics of charting analysis will be discussed for students to allow them to electronically invest in the stock market with a methodical approach. This class also outlines how independent investors can move with the market instead of against it, and increase their profits by relying on sound, time-tested rules, instead of emotions of fear, and greed. This is a course that will provide examples, as well as, clear, simple explanations to provide a solid framework to persevere in the market. Topics include:

- Review of first course principles, introduction to technical analysis, pattern recognition, market trends.
- Understanding moving averages, relative strength, momentum indicators, volume indicators.
- Understanding reversal pivot points, continuation pivot points, one day reversals, pull backs, flags, pennants, triangles.
- Candlestick charting.
- To short or not short the market.
- Understanding options.
- Understanding Bollinger bands and gap up and gap down.
- Review and modifying strategies.
